PARTICIPANT AGE: 18-24

PROGRAM PURPOSE:

The Brownfields Training Program will provide the following training to 100 young adults over a five-year period: 40-hour HAZWOPER (advanced), 8-hour HAZWOPER Supervisor (advanced), Lead Renovation Training (advanced), Asbestos Abatement Worker (initial), CPR/First Aid (advanced), CDL (advanced), and DOT Hazardous Materials (advanced). The target area for this grant is participants from the west end of Louisville. This community is primarily low-income, minority, and historically affected by economic disinvestment, health disparities, and disproportionate and adverse exposures to environmental contamination.
