PROGRAM PURPOSE:

The goal of our housing program is to provide case management and/or transitional or long-term housing placement for young adults experiencing homelessness. Our program offers comprehensive supportive services, such as access to mental health, transportation assistance, job training and more. Housing placement is only available to young adults who meet certain eligibility requirements.

NOTABLE ACCOMPLISHMENTS:

Since 2019, the housing office has provided long-term housing placement for over 150 youth and young adults and their families. Case management support for over 300 young adults and their families has also been provided to local youth.

Blueprint 502 operates four separate housing grants.

YHDP SSO: Total cost of the Project \$381,330. The Department for Housing and Urban Development is funding 79.95% of the project \$304,864. Local Community Resources are matching 43.1% of federal funds- \$76,466
YHDP RRH: Total cost of the Project is \$260,694. The Department for Housing and Urban Development is funding 79.7% of the project \$207,797. Local Community Resources are matching 20.3% of federal funds- \$52,897
Special NOFO SSO: Total cost of the Project is \$774,938. The Department for Housing and Urban Development is funding 80% of the project \$619,938. Local Community Resources are matching 20% of federal funds- \$155,000.
Special NOFO RRH: Total cost of the Project is \$1,181,601. The Department for Housing and Urban Development is funding 80% of the project \$945,281. Local Community Resources are matching 20% of federal funds- \$236,320.
TH-RRH: Total cost of the Project is \$376,865. The Department for Housing and Urban Development is funding 82.04% of the project \$309,172. Local Community Resources are matching 17.96% of federal funds- \$67,693
