WHAT IS A BROWNFIELD?

A "brownfield" is a property on which the expansion, redevelopment, or reuse may be complicated by the presence or potential presence of a hazardous substance, pollutant, or contaminant.

FREE TRAINING PROGRAM!

Blueprint 502 will be training students in Brownfields assessment, remediation techniques and preparing them for environmental jobs. The training program includes 261 hours (6-8 weeks) of instruction and participants will earn up to seven federal certifications. Participants that complete the program are elgible for a \$500 stipend. Additionally, Brownfields Jobs earn annual salaries of \$50,000-90,000. TARC passes are offered for participants.
