### WHAT IS A BROWNFIELD?

A "brownfield" is a property on which the expansion, redevelopment, or reuse may be complicated by the presence or potential presence of a hazardous substance, pollutant, or contaminant.

### FREE TRAINING PROGRAM!

Blueprint 502 will be training students in Brownfields assessment, remediation techniques and preparing them for environmental jobs. The training program includes 261 hours (6-8 weeks) of instruction and participants will earn up to seven federal certifications. Participants that complete the program are eligible for a \$500 stipend. Additionally, Brownfields Jobs earn annual salaries of \$50,000-90,000. TARC passes are offered for participants.
